Traveling with your Pet:

Planning and preparation are necessary when traveling with family pets. A few general tips apply whether your travel by car or plane.

- **Be sure your Pet is properly identified with a current tag and/ or a microchip.**
- Be sure to have both proof of rabies vaccination and current health certificate with you when crossing state or international borders.

Our Doctors suggest taking a current copy of all medical issues being treated and a list of all medications your pet is on to have in case, you must seek medical attention. If your pet will be crated for travel, mark the crate with all pertinent information – names, phone numbers and addresses. These extra steps are well worth the peace of mind.

It only takes a minute for a tragedy to occur – please do not leave pets in the car during the warm weather months or in the winter when the threat of temperatures are near or below freezing.
