Membership Meeting Minutes

Commodore Bob McDonnell called the March 2003 meeting of Landmark Yacht Club to order at 3:00 PM. The meeting was held with 26 members attending. John Ashton led the invocation.

Officer Reports

Commodore Bob McDonnell asked for introduction of guests and John Ashton introduced Mr. Dwayne Love. Harald also introduced members of his family that are visiting. Bob reminded members that the Clubhouse and facilities are closed after the December meeting and Christmas party and not opened until the March meeting of the following year. It appears that someone has been using the facilities and not locking the restrooms. The restrooms are winterized from December to March and are off-limits during this time.

Vice Commodore Gregg Reynolds presented the 2003 work list and a copy is posted at the Clubhouse. He has assigned each member workdays and outlined work to be performed. He restated that if a member is not able to make an assigned workday, that member must contact another as a replacement. Next month it appears that we will try to place some rip-rap along the shoreline and build a small jetty.

Also, we intend to build a boat rack for the small boats and a walk ramp from the parking lot to make it easier to use a cart to bring items to and from the Clubhouse and the boats. Thanks to Andy Myruski for repairing the broken window at the club.

Rear Commodore Harald Seiler distributed a final list of slip and mooring assignments. All slips are full, only moorings are available. Harald also discussed the effects of static electricity and will hold a seminar at the Club in May. He cautioned that swimming should be restricted to within 50 feet of the pier and moored boats. All boats will be checked this year for electrical leakage.

Fleet Captain Gary Farrell will organize and hold a boating class in the near future. This is a good way for all of us to learn the different ways that various boats handle (single screw, twin screw, mooring, etc.). Also, Gary prepared and presented a calendar of events for the upcoming season and posted the schedule on the club's bulletin board.

Secretary Angelo Christiano stated that the newsletter will be posted on our website and those having access may want to download the newsletter in the future to avoid our large monthly postage fees. However, those without access to the website will continue to receive club information by mail.

Treasurer Don Basham presented his treasurers report and stated that 42 members have paid their dues. Don announced the balances in the Club's bank accounts and stated that we are in good financial health.

Membership: Charlie Wilkerson stated that Dwayne Love is being sponsored by John Ashton as a new member. Charlie also stated that LYC sportswear is available and provided a catalog for members to review and provide him with their orders.

Program & Attendance Chairperson Renay Galati prepared and posted a list of events and meals for the rest of the year. However, there are still openings for volunteers to provide meals in June thru October. Please see Renay to sign up. She welcomes suggestions on this and any ideas for other events.



The meal following the April meeting will be a Potato Bar provided by the Galati's, as well as salad, bread and desserts provided by other assigned individuals. Members are asked to provide their own beverages.
